The Tehama County Transportation Commission (Commission) is soliciting applications for nine (9) positions of the Tehama County Social Services Advisory Council (Council). The Council will have advisory responsibilities with recommendations presented to the Commission regarding the transit needs of transit dependent and transit disadvantaged persons, including the elderly, handicapped and persons of limited means.

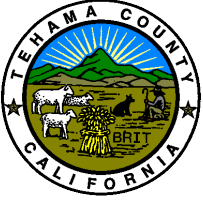
The members shall be appointed by the Commissioners of the Tehama County Transportation Commission, upon recommendation of the majority of the members of the Council.

The Commissioners shall take into consideration all of the following criteria when recommending and appointing members. These criteria are mandatory and are a requirement of the categories established in Public Utilities Code Section 99238.

- One (1) representative of potential transit users who is age 60 years or older;
- One (1) representative of potential transit users who are handicapped;
- Two (2) representatives of the local social service providers for seniors, including one representative of a social service transportation provider, if one exists;
- Two (2) representatives of local social service providers for the disabled, including one representative of a social service transportation provider,
- One (1) representative of a local social service provider for persons of limited means;
- Two (2) representatives from the local consolidated transportation service agency, designated pursuant to subdivision (a) of Section 15975 of the Government Code, including one representative from an operator.

The term of office for the initial appointments to Council shall be one-third of them be for a one-year term, one-third shall be for a two-year term and one-third shall be for a three-year term. Subsequent to the initial appointment, the term of appointment shall be for three years, which may be renewed for an additional three-year term.
